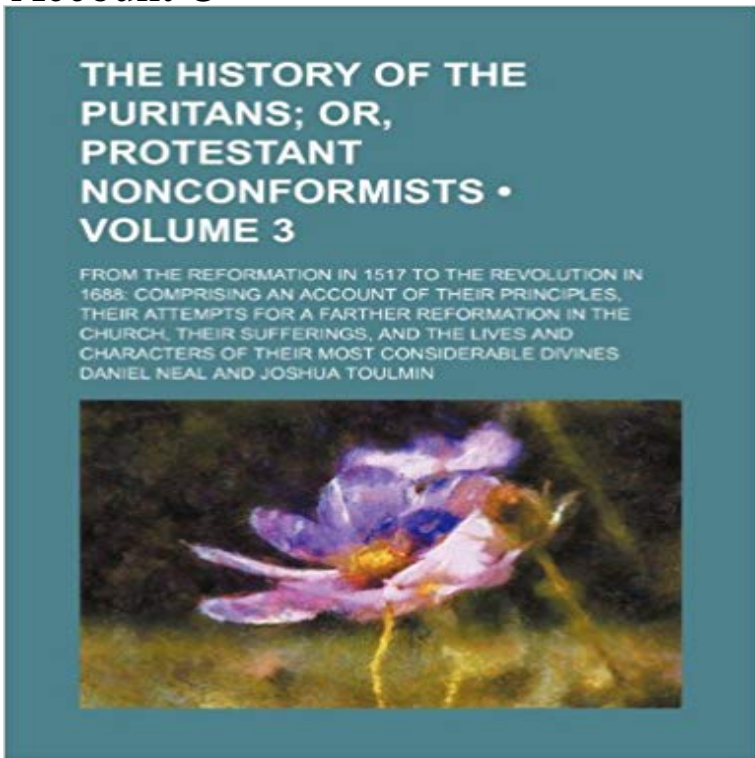

The parliament had such an esteem for him, that they named him one of the assembly of divines, and he had the goodness to appear among them for some time. Upon the bishops complaint, that the profits of his bishoprick were detained, the committee ordered them to be restored, and gave him a pass to go to Bristol to receive them, wherein they style him a person of great learning and merit. He died in possession of his bishoprick, June 25, 1644, aged seventy-one, and composed his own epitaph, one line of which was, t / Y ,: ;:., i ..: Senio et moerore confectm.. . ., I Worn qui witU age and grief,,,,t And another;.... Episcoporum iufimus, pccatorum primus. The least of bishops, the greatest of sinners. Dr. Calibute Downing was born of an ancient family in Gloucestershire, about 1616; he was educated in Oriel-college, Oxford, and at length became vicar of Hackney near London, by the procurement of archbishop Laud; which is very strange, if, as Mr. Wood says, he always looked awry on the chnrch. In his sermon before the Artillery-company, Septemher 1,1640, he maintained, that for the defence of religion and reformation of the church, it was lawful to take up arms against the king, if it could be obtained no other way. For this he was forced to abscond till the beginning of the present parliament. He was afterward chaplain in the earl of Essexs army, and a member of the assembly of divines; but died before he was forty years ot age, having the character of a pious man, a warm preacher, and very zealous in the
