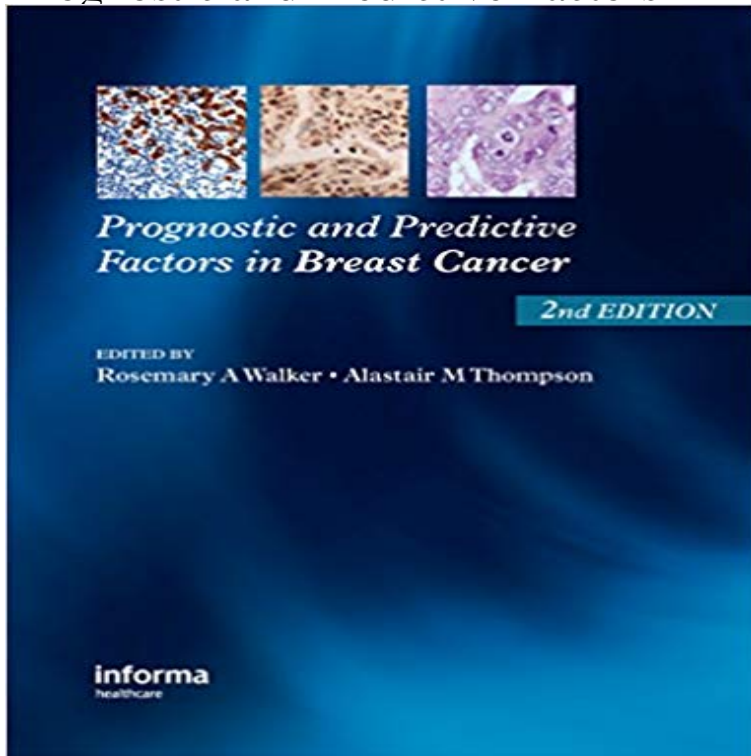


Prognostic and Predictive Factors in Breast Cancer
