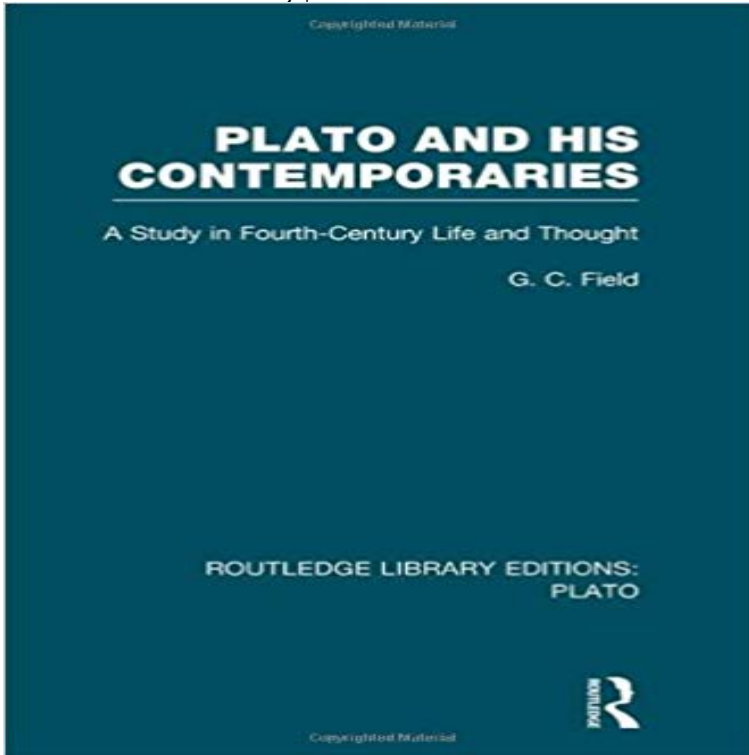


Plato and His Contemporaries (RLE: Plato): A Study in Fourth Century Life and Thought

The remainder of the work considers the total setting political, literary and philosophical in which Platos writings were produced. There are extensive appendices on the Platonic Epistles, Aristotle and the Theory of Ideas, and on the post-Aristotelian tradition. The result is both a lucid account of Plato himself and a comprehensive view of culture in fifth century Greece.
