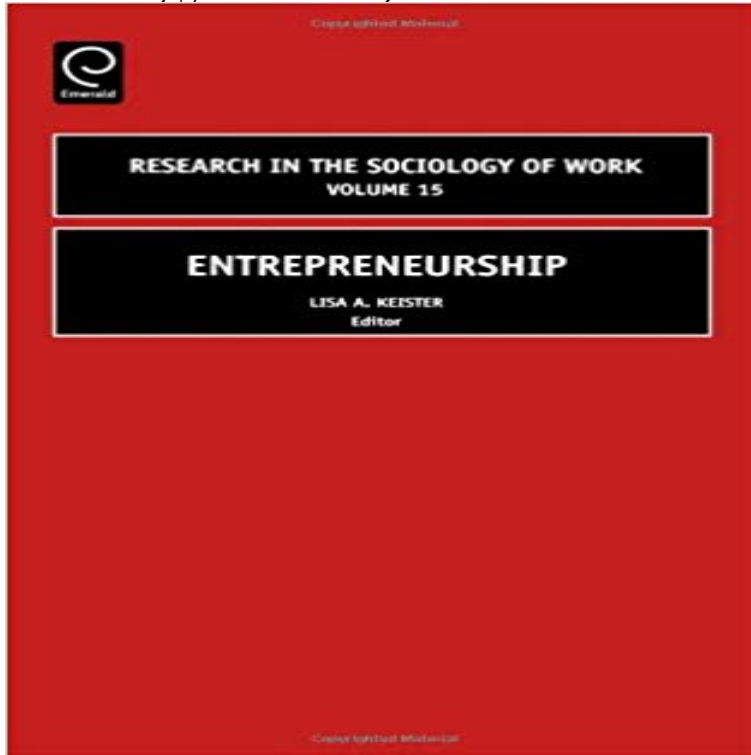


Entrepreneurship (Research in the Sociology of Work) (Research in the Sociology of Work)
