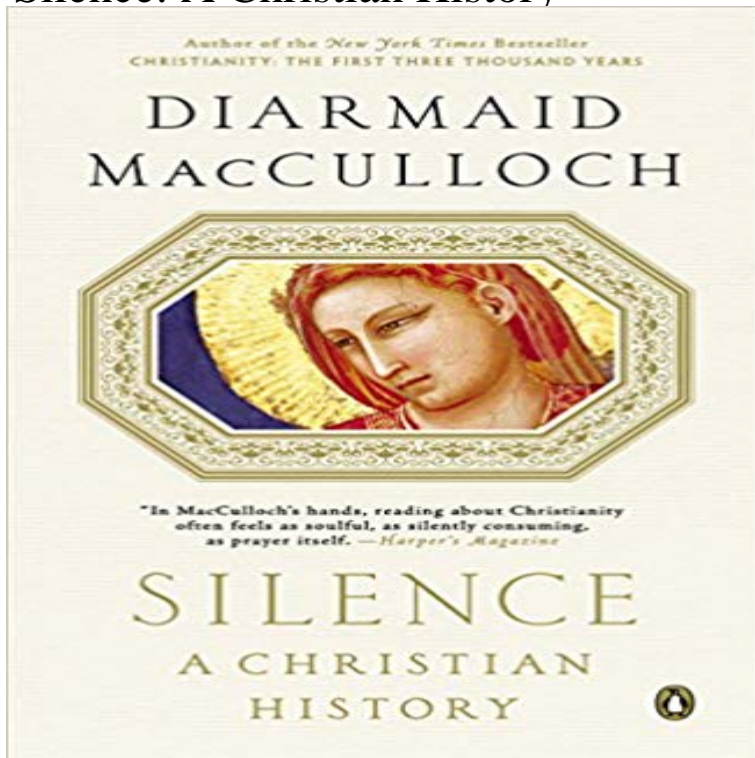


Silence: A Christian History
