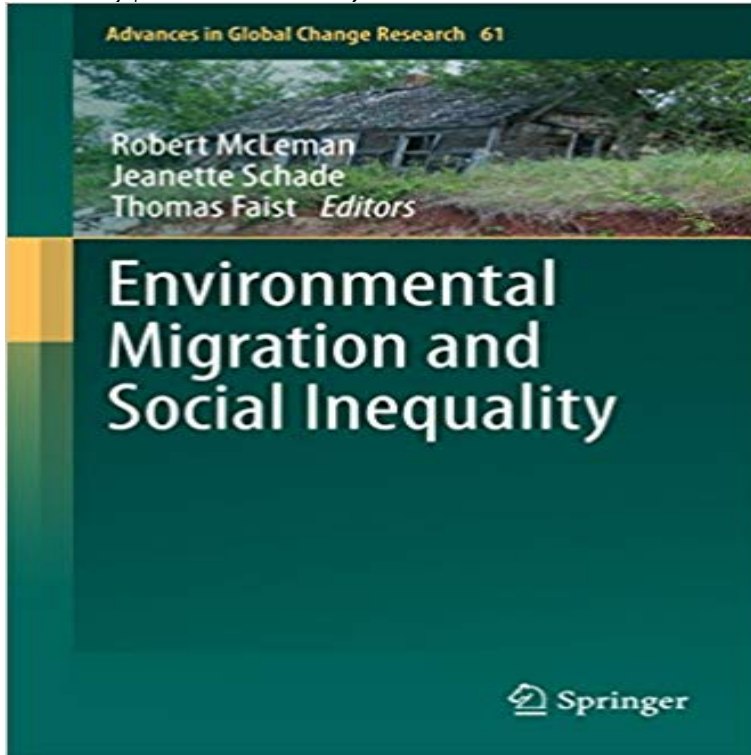


Environmental Migration and Social Inequality (Advances in Global Change Research)
