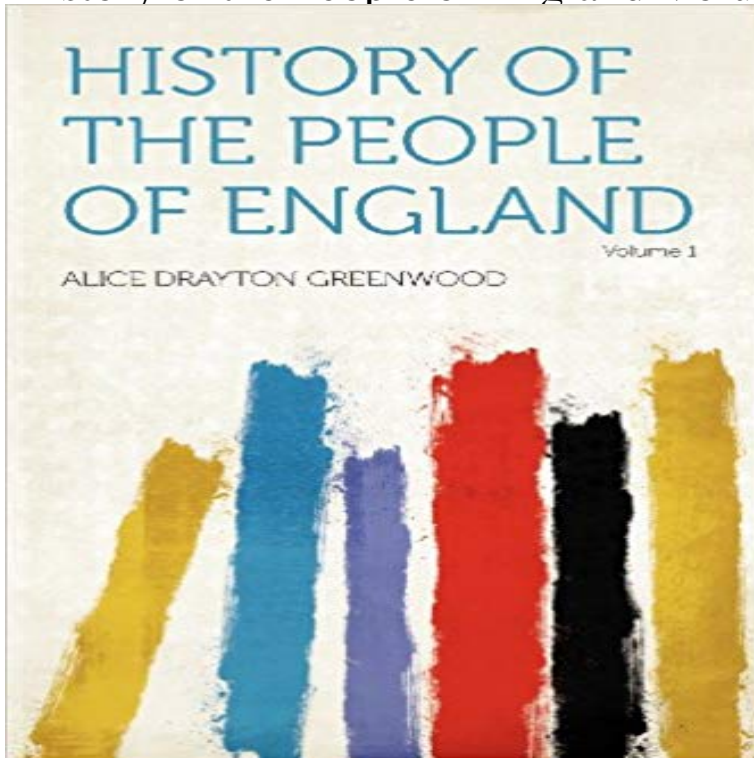


History of the People of England Volume 1
