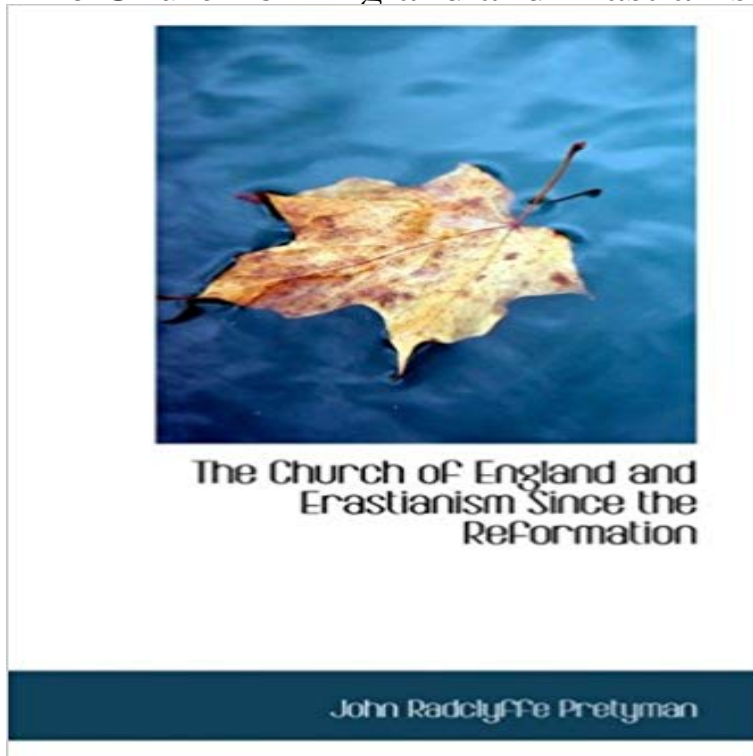


The Church of England and Erastianism Since the Reformation
