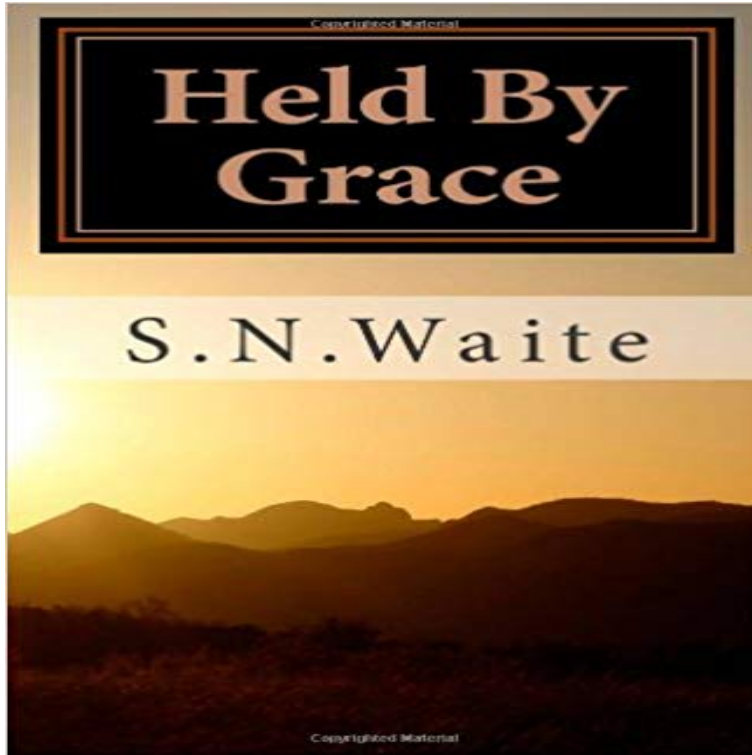


Held By Grace: Reflections on How God Faithfully Works in His Childrens Lives
