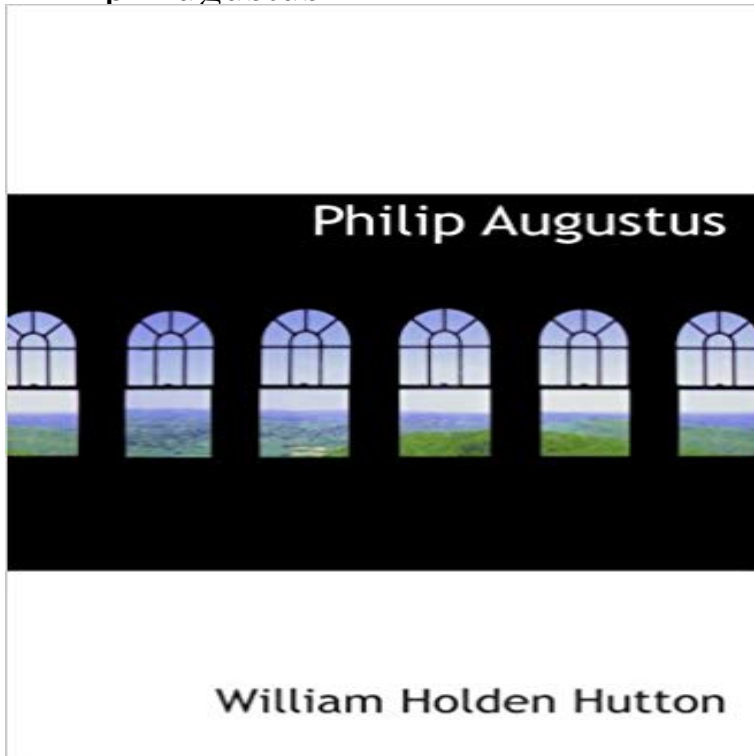


Philip Augustus
