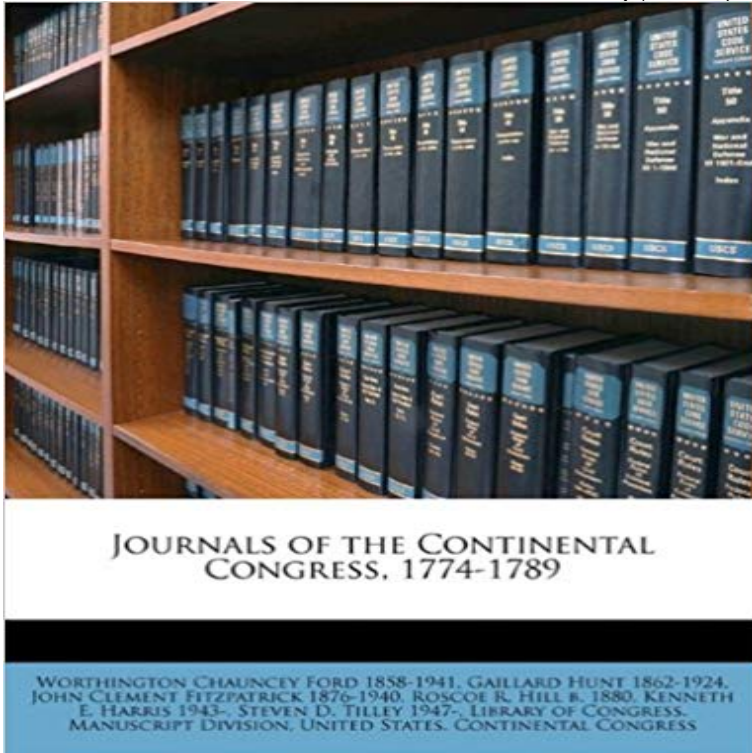


Journals of the Continental Congress, 1774-1789 Volume 26
