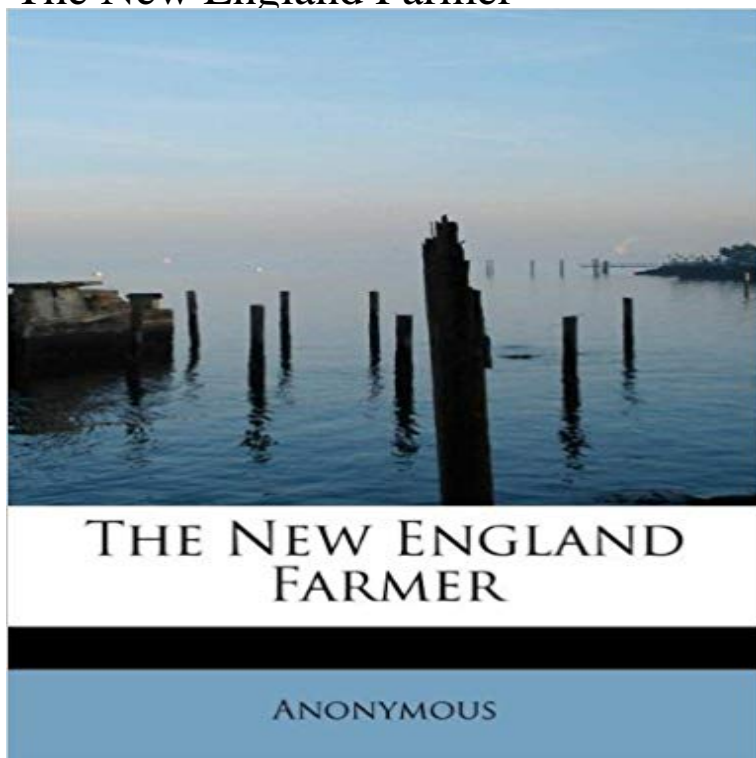


## The New England Farmer
