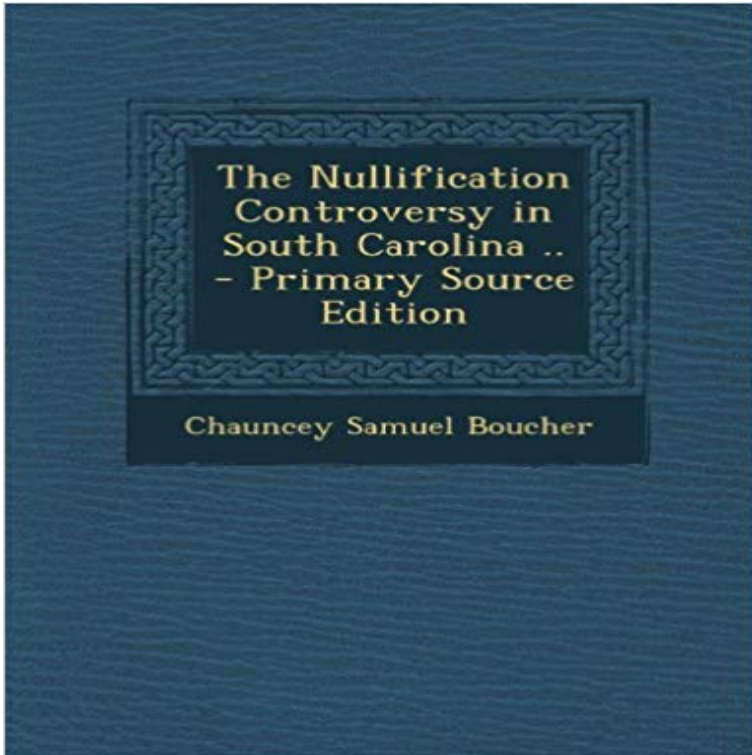


# The Nullification Controversy in South Carolina .. - Primary Source Edition
