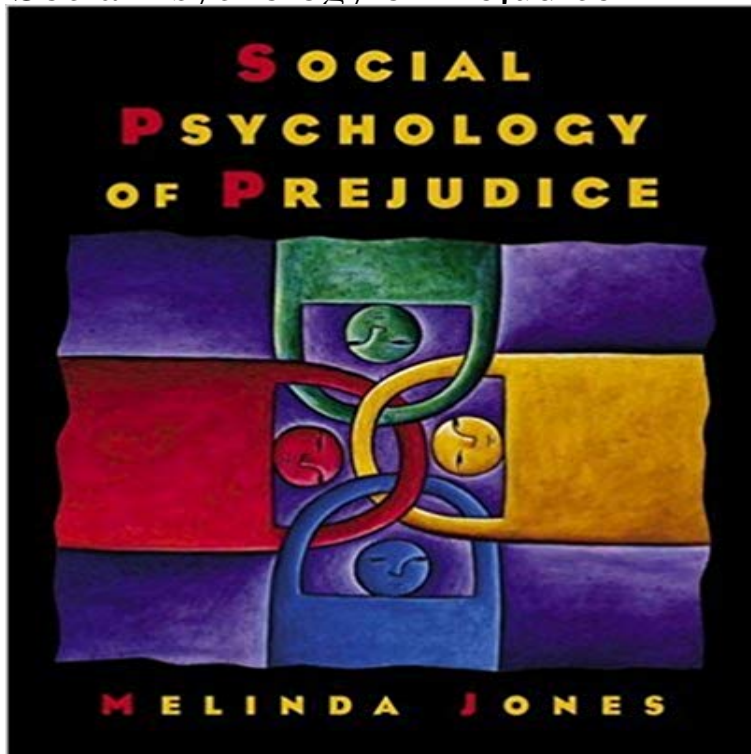


Social Psychology of Prejudice
