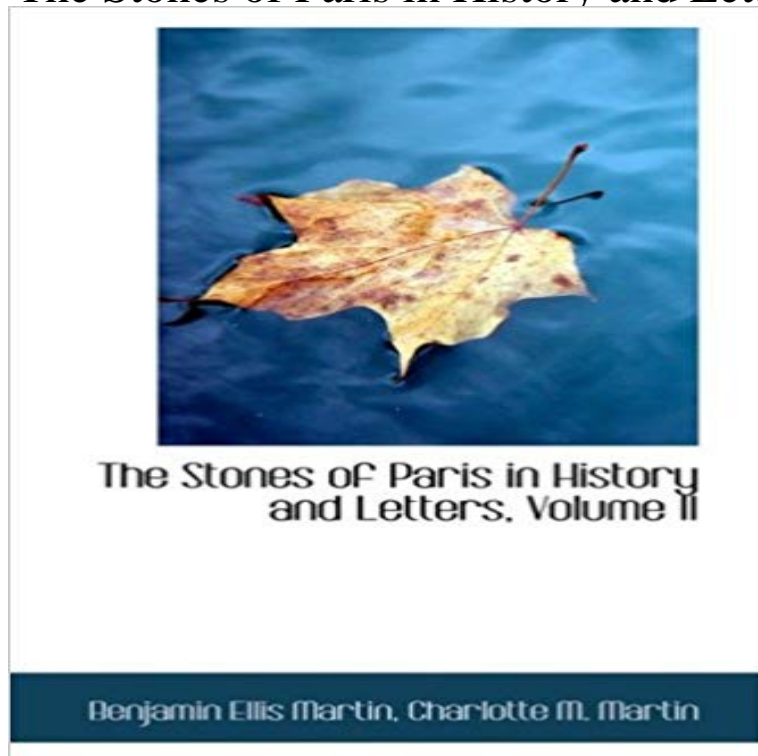


## The Stones of Paris in History and Letters, Volume II
