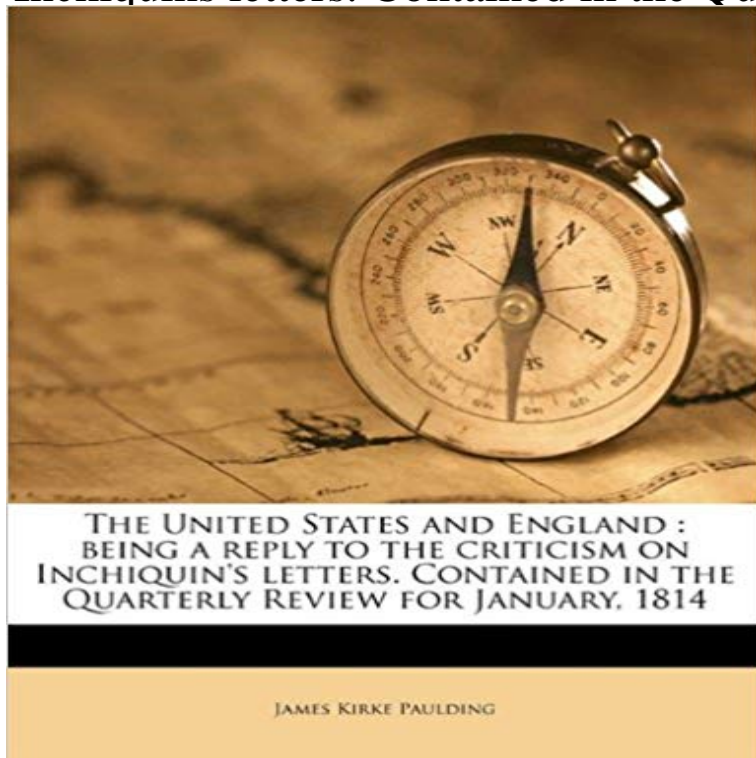


The United States and England: being a reply to the criticism on Inchiquins letters. Contained in the Quarterly Review for January, 1814
