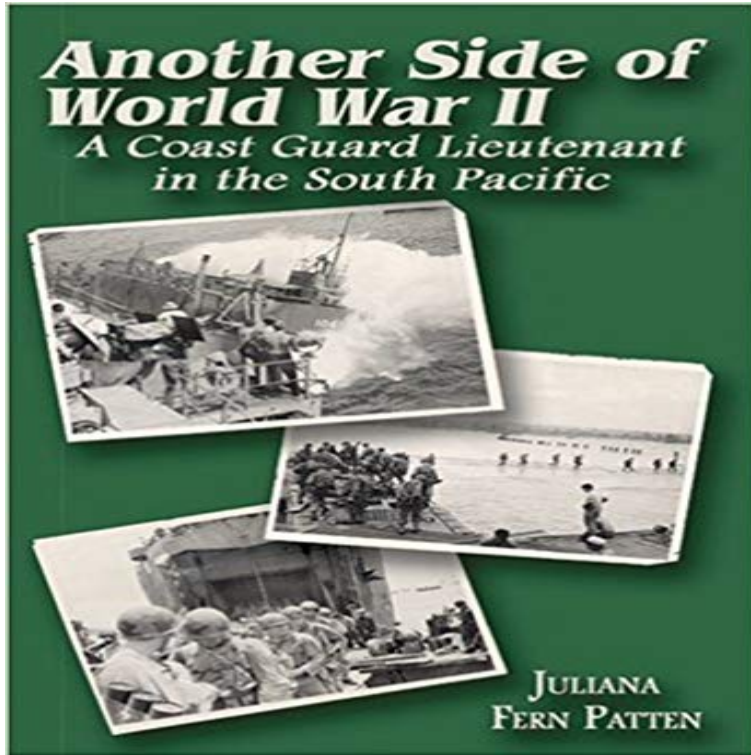


Another Side of World War II: A Coast Guard Lieutenant in the South Pacific

He embraces every situation with an eagerness for novelty and excitement. Ferns gift for language, marked not only by scholarliness but lightheartedness as well, is a refreshing blend of fluency and vitality. His appreciation and extensive knowledge of nature enhance his eloquent descriptions of the islands, the sky, and the sea. His narrative is enticing and entertaining while at the same time informative and educational. These letters present a stimulating view of the events of WWII constructed by a person who lived them during his assignment in the South Pacific. They speak to us across time, offering a personal perspective of living history. One need not be a military buff to appreciate this first-person war story. *Another Side of World War II* will hold the attention of a wide audience.
