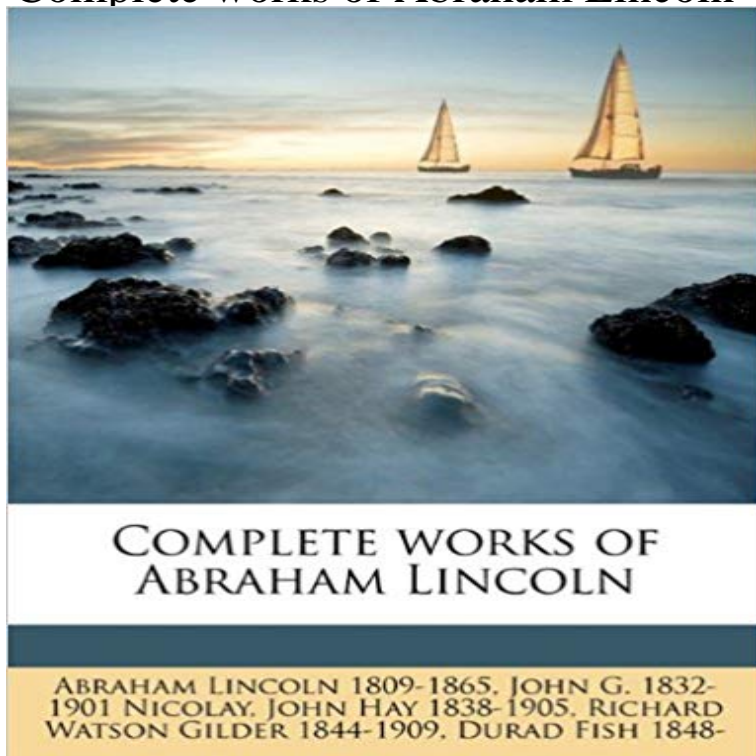


Complete works of Abraham Lincoln Volume 1
