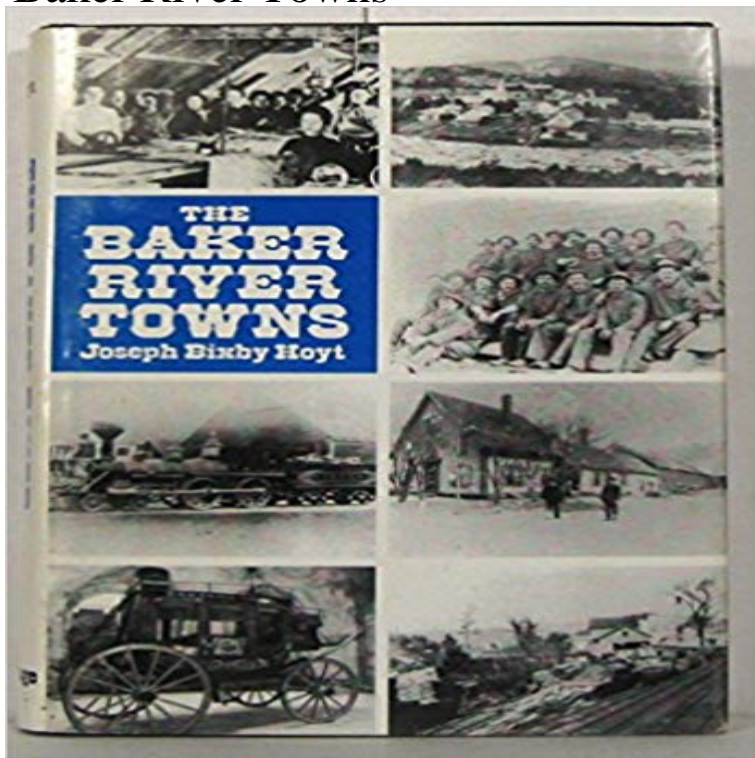


## Baker River Towns
