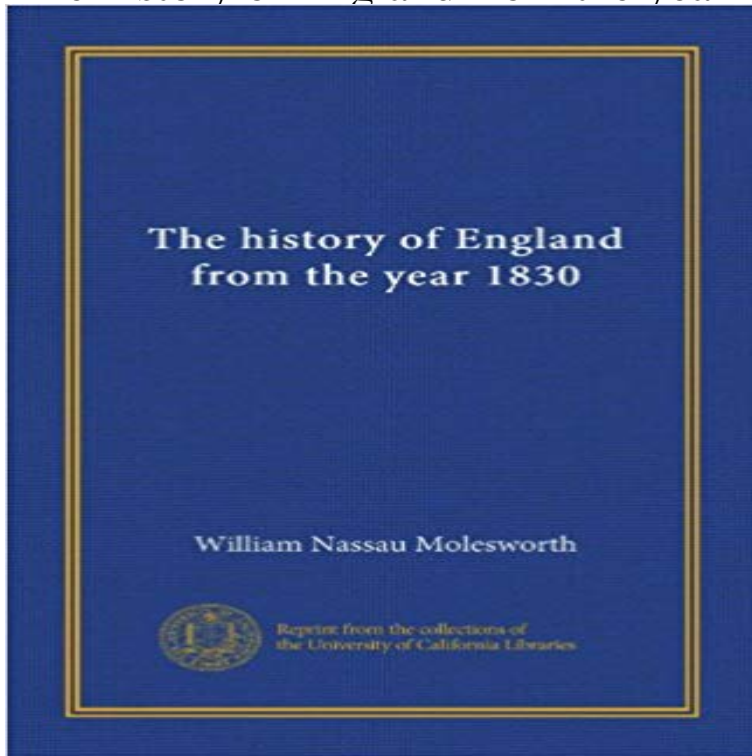


The history of England from the year 1830 (v.3)
