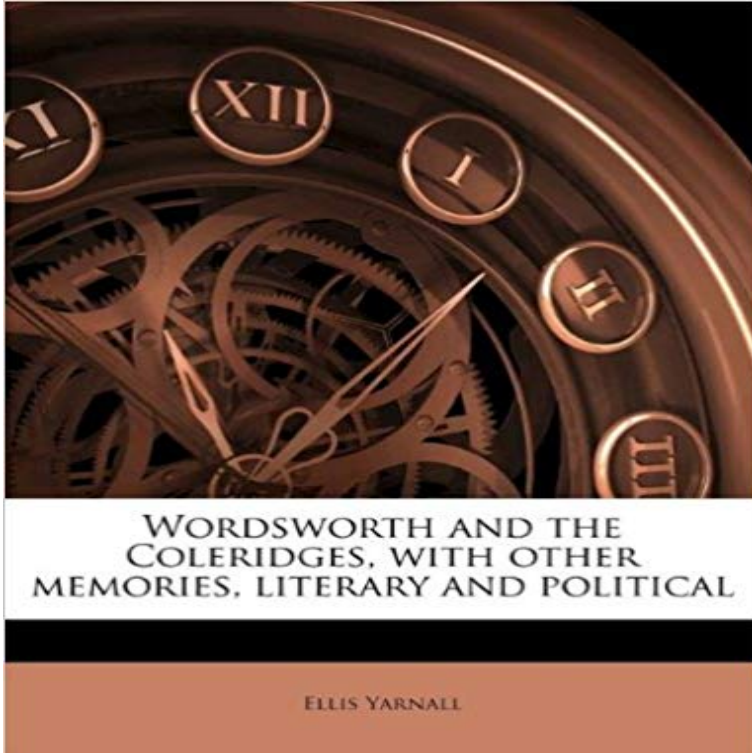


Wordsworth and the Coleridges, with other memories, literary and political
